About Us	BUCKS CRICKET CIO ("we", "our" or "us") is the governing body responsible for the organisation, administration, regulation, development and promotion of recreational cricket within Buckinghamshire. The Personal Data We Process	Depending on your involvement with Bucks Cricket, we may collect and process the following categories of personal data: • Full name, including any known-as name • Address • Date of birth and age • Contact number • Email address • Gender • Social media • Photographs and video images (including live streams) and social media content • Club, league, team or cricket organisation affiliations • School name/type (primary and secondary) • Ethnicity and Nationality • Health and medical information where relevant • Maturation data (height and weight) • Data collected for ECB EDI funding purposes: ○ Siblings in the same household ○ Parent / Carer landscape – single parents, work type, work base ○ Access to transport / car ○ Family make up e.g. single or co parents / carers, living with family members etc. ○ Education Health Care Plans (EHCPs) ○ English is an additional language (EAL)

Where We Will Hold Your Personal Data	We will normally keep your personal data within the UK or European Economic Area (EEA). Where personal data is transferred outside the UK, appropriate safeguards will be implemented in accordance with UK data protection legislation.	
How Long We Will Keep Your Personal Data For	We will retain personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes described in this notice. Retention periods will depend on: • Regulatory requirements • ECB governance requirements	

	• Safeguarding obligations • Insurance requirements • Legal limitation periods • The nature of the information concerned Disciplinary and safeguarding records may be retained for extended periods where required by law, regulation or safeguarding considerations. At the end of the applicable retention period, personal data will be securely deleted or anonymised. To remove Bucks Cricket's access to your Play-Cricket data, you can do this at any time within your profile settings by removing your association with Bucks Cricket or by deleting your account.
Your Legal Rights Over Your Personal Data And Complaints	Where you have given your consent to processing, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. This will not affect the lawfulness of any processing undertaken before consent was withdrawn.
