- 43 Clubs within Bucks have at least one player on our Pathway

- 187 Boys (73%) from 2025 were re-selected on the Pathway.
 105 new Boys players were selected onto the Pathway.
- 127 Girls (82%) from 2025 year were re-selected on the Pathway.
 62 new Girls players were selected onto the Pathway.

Player's maturation status was calculated and considered when making selections:

• 51% of all U10-16 Boys that were nominated were selected onto the Pathway, 55% of Boys Late-Developers selected.

71% of all U10-16 Girls that were nominated were selected onto the Pathway, 75% of Girls Late-Developers selected.

PATHWAY SUPPORT

BURSARY FUNDING

- We provided £8,813 of bursary funding to reduce the cost for players in financial need in 2025. This supported
 winter training, fixtures and tours.
- We have already provided £2,695 of bursary funding for 2026 winter training.

COST REDUCTION FOR ALL PATHWAY PLAYERS

- **ECB grant** of £28,751 helped subsidise the cost of fixtures for all players and the costs of performance programmes.
- Nomination Sessions were free for all players, costing Bucks Cricket £9,735.

STATE SCHOOL PLAYERS

MCC Foundation Hubs (Free training sessions – funded by MCCF):

- **2026:** 13 Hubs: MK & South Bucks: U14 & U17 Girls x3, U13 & U15 Boys x3. Includes new Performance Hubs at each age-group and new Boys U13 High Wycombe.
- 2025: 9 Hubs: MK & South Bucks: U12 Girls, U14 & U16 Girls x2, U14 & U16 Boys x2.
- 2024: 8 Hubs: MK & South Bucks: U14 & U16 Girls x2, U14 & U16 Boys x2.

State School Boosters (heavily subsidised by Bucks Cricket)

- 2026: 54 hours of 3-1 coaching for Girls and Boys U13-U16s (more also planned for New Year), 78 hours of group sessions for Girls U10-U12, Boys U10-14s.
- 2025: 187 hours of 2-1 coaching for Girls and Boys U13-U16s.
